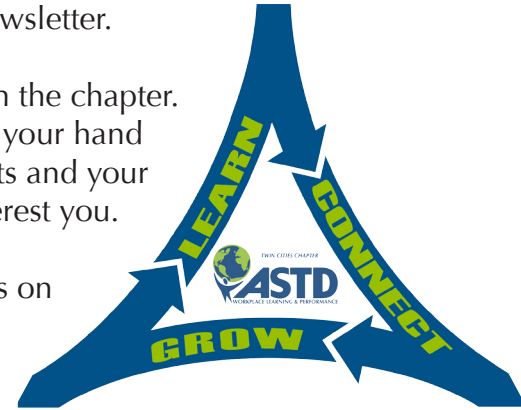


# Get more from your membership. Get involved.
